Our body needs energy from food. Our digestive system digests food for our body.

What happens in our mouth?

Our **teeth** make food soft when we chew. It goes down the **oesophagus** into our **stomach**.

What happens in our stomach?

Our stomach digests the food we eat. Food can stay in our stomach for four hours.

What happens in our intestines?

Digested food goes through the wall of the **small intestine** into the blood. Then the blood carries the things we need around our body. The **large intestine** helps to eliminate the parts of food that we don't need.

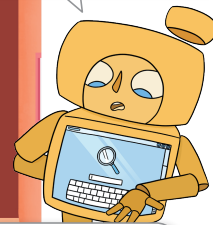

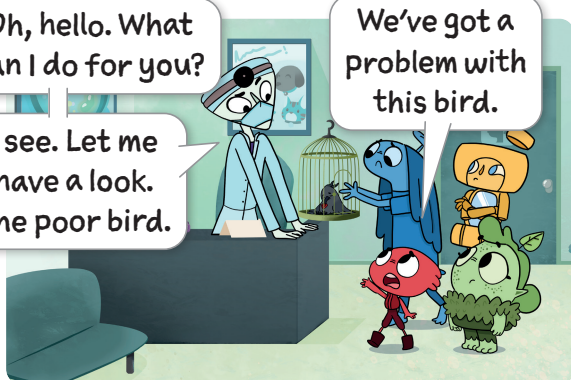

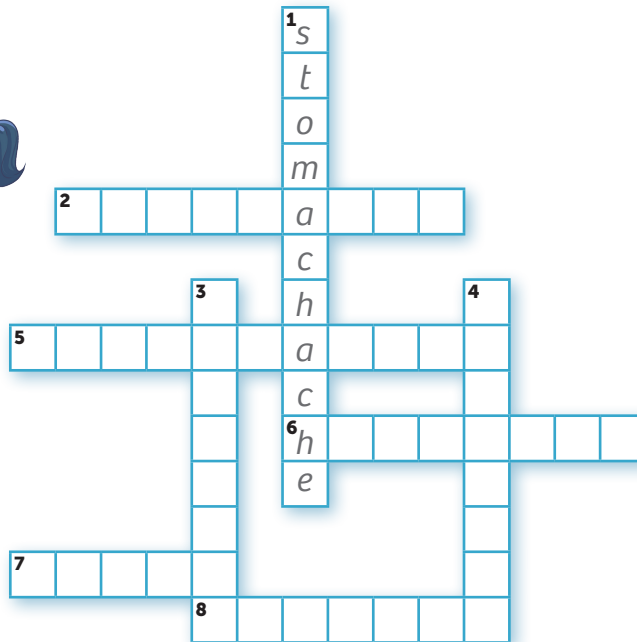
