INTERESTING INSECTS

Insects don't live for very long. For example, some butterflies live for a year, but some only live for a day!

Some insects, like bees and butterflies, have got four stages of metamorphosis in their life cycle; egg, larva, pupa and adult.

Other insects, like grasshoppers, praying mantises and dragonflies, have got three stages of metamorphosis. When the baby hatches from an egg, it looks like a small adult. It is called a nymph.

When nymphs grow, they change their skin! Grasshopper nymphs do this about five times and praying mantises about eight times.

Dragonfly nymphs live under water for two or three years!
